During the prolonged government shutdown of 2019, The American Legion provided more than \$1 million in TFA grants to Coast Guard families who were experiencing pay interruptions. Your continued support of the Veterans & Children Foundation is most appreciated.

Priority one for The American Legion is to save veterans' lives. Our Be the One message to prevent veteran suicide is making a difference. VA is now required by law to conduct an annual buddy check week to encourage peer support and outreach to vulnerable veterans. If you or someone that you know is having suicidal thoughts, I implore you to call 988, the national crisis line.
