RULES FOR THE AWARD:

1. Nominee must be a resident of CONNECTICUT.
2. Nominee must have contributed to the promotion of true Americanism.
3. Nominee's contribution must have been performed on a STATEWIDE OR REGIONAL BASIS AND BE OF A CURRENT NATURE, **OR**, may be of a cumulative nature (over a period of years or one's lifetime).
4. Multiple nominations for one individual will count as one entry.
5. **ONLY OFFICIAL APPLICATION FORM WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
6. Multiple Nominations (of different individuals) **will now** be allowed for every Post.

Since Americanism* is one of our four basic programs, The American Legion has devoted great effort in this regard.

Posts are requested to give serious thought to the nomination of an individual who meets the requirements for this award. The nominee is not required to be a veteran or a member of The American Legion. One thing that all Posts should keep in mind when selecting the nominee is that this is a **DEPARTMENT AWARD** and the service of the individual should be on a larger basis than service to the local community and must be of a current nature, or of a cumulative nature (over a period of years or one's lifetime).

The Department Americanism Commission earnestly solicits the active cooperation of every Post in the Department in the submission of nominees for this Award.

The Award will be presented at the 105th Department Convention in Trumbull, CT.
