My fellow Legionnaires,

I hope everyone's Christmas and New Years holidays with family and friends went well, now it is time to get back to the business at hand. The next few months are the critical months that will make or break us as far as membership goes. I need everyone's help if we are going to achieve that 100% goal by May 13th that we as a department strive for. I urge everyone to start sending letters, making phone calls and even making personal contact with your members who have not renewed yet. We all know why we need to maintain our current membership, but more importantly we all know why it is so important that we continue to grow our membership if we are to continue to work our programs and serve our veterans within our own state.

As of today, December 26th, 2025, Department of CT is 24th in the nation with 10,558 current members out of a goal of 13,500 for 2026. Our total percentage rating is 78.207% but our retention only percentage is 76.927% and that's a number to be proud of also.

As we get close to the middle of the 2026 membership year, we have 10 posts at 100% Posts 59, 201, 34, 71, 202, 208, 161, 27, 46, and 192. Congratulations to these posts on reaching 100% before December 31st. There are 9 posts that are 90 - 99.9% or better, 41 posts at 80-89.9 %. Congratulations are also due to all these posts that have made the 80% percent target date before the actual date. There are now also 23 posts that have attained the national quota of 75-79.99%. All others please continue to work hard to get your members to renew. The 80% national target date is January 14th, which means all posts that are under the 80 % mark have great opportunities to get to that point.

Please come for our featured class instructed by National staff member Ken George, Liaison to the National Judge Advocate- on **How to keep your post out of trouble & legal opinion on SAL as pertaining to the IRS**. 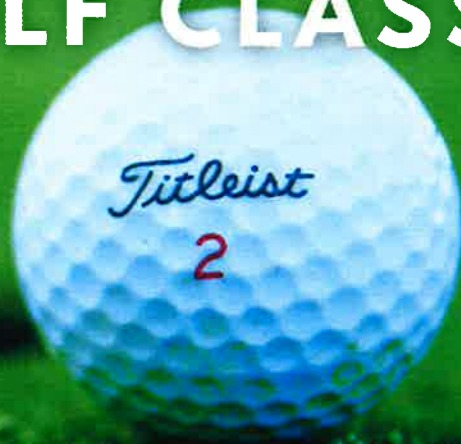

Faces of Freedom preserves and archives the personal histories and images of United States Military veterans and Holocaust survivors. The personal histories are collected through in-person interviews and a photo session. Each interview is used to create a biography that covers the highlights of the veteran's entire life, not just their time in the military. Each veteran is provided with a matted and framed black and white portrait at no charge. Each story and photo is then posted to a website (www.facesoffreedom.us) and Facebook page. Currently there are 172 veterans and 4 Holocaust survivor stories and photos on the website.

All veterans have a unique story of their military service. Some are funny, some are sad, some are heroic, but all of these stories need to be recorded, preserved and shared with the other 93.9% of us that didn't serve.

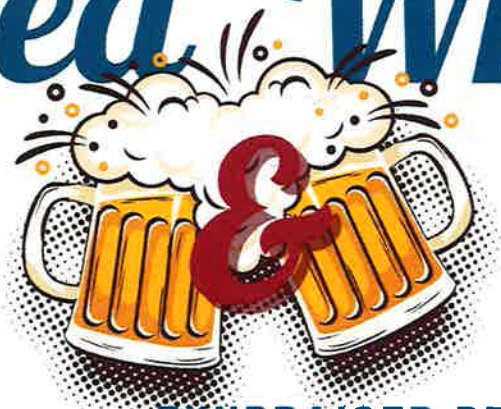

We are expanding this life-changing program to include **first responders**—firefighters, police officers, emergency medical responders, and more. For the past few years, we've proudly matched rescue dogs with veterans, and now we are honored to offer the same incredible support to those who serve our communities every day.

Dog Star Heroes Adoption Process

We are proud to have a special adoption program offering **exclusive pricing and perks for:**

- **Honorably discharged U.S. veterans**
- **Active duty military members**
- **First responders** including:
 - Firefighters
 - Police officers
 - Emergency medical responders
 - Doctors & Nurses

Steps to Adoption:

- Complete an [online adoption application](#). There is a field in the application asking if you or your partner are a veteran, active military member, or a first responder.
- **Veterans and active military members:** Proof of military service with a U.S. Military ID Card is required, designating honorable discharge if not currently active.
- **Disabled veterans:** A letter from the veteran's personal physician attesting to their suitability for a companion dog is required.
- **First responders:** No proof of service is required.
- All applicants will have an interview with our **Dog Star Heroes team** to learn more about your home environment and what you are looking for in a rescue dog.
- We may meet applicants at their homes and conduct home visits as needed, including follow-up visits after adoption, to ensure the best match for you and your dog. This is part of our adoption contract.
- **Veterans and first responders:** We will reimburse **50% of the cost of one 6-week basic skills obedience class** (up to \$200) with a pre-approved trainer.
- Upon completion of the training, a certificate will be required as proof.

Adoption Fee Discounts:

- **100% of the adoption fee covered for disabled veterans** (currently \$500 for dogs over four months and under age seven)
- **50% of the adoption fee covered for honorably discharged veterans, active military members, and first responders** (currently \$250)
- **Veterans agree to allow Dog Star Heroes access to veterinary records for the life of the dog** as part of the adoption agreement.
